- Manifestation Charisms Overview - Jessica Navin (see Sanctifying and Charismatic Gifts Slides)
 - The Holy Spirit is a Sanctifier and Artisan molding us into the image of Jesus
 - There are two kinds of grace (Aquinas):
 - “Sanctifying” which unites a person to God, we all have this at baptism - it is for us
 - “Gratuitous” (Charismatic) which is bestowed on a person for the benefit of another person’s justification - it is for others
 - Seven sanctifying (Isaiah) gifts are given to all of us for our holiness: Fear of the Lord, Piety, Knowledge, Understanding, Counsel, Wisdom, Fortitude
 - Gratuitous (Manifestation) gifts/charisms are given as the Spirit wills (we all have some, but no one has all) - for the good of others - no set list
 - We receive them if we believe and say “yes” to God’s gifts, need to desire them
 - Jesus promised an outpouring of charisms (Mk 16:17-18)
 - The Apostles urged the Churches to seek spiritual gifts (charisms) for the benefit of the communities (1 Cor 14:1, 1 Pt 4:10)
 - Church Fathers (e.g. Iranaeus, 150 AD) acknowledged charisms working in the Church
 - Vatican II urged the acceptance and use of charisms (Lumen Gentium 12)
 - 1 Cor 12 talks of nine gifts/charisms (grouping below is for ease of discussion, charisms are talked about in other ways also)
 - Action Charisms, the power to DO: Faith, Healing, Miracles
 - Revelation Charisms, the power to KNOW: Word of Knowledge, Word of Wisdom, Discernment of Spirits
 - Word Charisms, the power to SAY: Tongues, Interpretation of Tongues, Prophecy
 - These Charisms will be explored in detail in Sep-Nov LEL retreats
- Spiritual Reflection: (Journaling Questions handout)
 - The Holy Spirit wants to mold us into Jesus, to make Jesus manifest in us through the charisms
 - Portrait of Jesus video - we need to become a portrait of Jesus
 - God wants us to serve and bring fruit to the earth, to heal destruction and distortions
 - We have to desire to find God and accept His invitation of love - we have to be Christ in the world
 - We are given gifts/charisms to use to do this (parable of the “Talents” (Mt 25:14-29)), use them, don’t bury them
 - We must join with God, say “yes” to the charisms/gifts and manifest God’s love to the world

 - Reflect on the similarity and differences of this creative exercise to the receipt and presentation of the Manifestation Charisms
