

Description: God as the Eternal Creator 2 - We want to start off in Hebrews 11:1. Familiar passage of scripture, this writer says, “Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. For by it the people of old received their commendation. By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things that are visible”. In lesson number 1 of this quarter we talked about how knowing God is what matters most, knowing God is the greatest need that mankind possibly has.
