Hi I'm Becky McAllister, Financial Aid Specialist at Eastern Wyoming College. Ever wonder what other types of grants and scholarships are available in the state of Wyoming?

For Wyoming students who are ineligible for Hathaway, there is another scholarship opportunity for you through the Craig and Susan Thomas Foundation.

To be eligible for this scholarship students must have a high school diploma or the equivalent, be accepted into their school and/or program, have Wyoming and U.S. citizenship, and they must NOT be eligible or receiving the Hathaway scholarship. They also must plan to attend a Wyoming school or program.

There is a preference given to learners who are considered "at-risk," but that can mean simply that you are a non-traditional student or that you do not meet Hathaway requirements. Unlike the Hathaway, there is no age requirement for this scholarship. You can download an application at the Craig and Susan Thomas Foundation website.

Applications for the fall semester are due by May 1st of the current year. Applications for the spring semester are due by November 1st of the current year. The scholarship awards up to \$1300 per semester for full-time students and a maximum award of \$675 per semester for part-time students.
