3. "The tree of life (22:2) most certainly bears great significance in God's written revelation to mankind. What do we learn in Revelation 22 about the tree of life? Why is it so significant?
4. "No longer will there be any accursed" (22:3) What does this promise mean?
5. What is meant by referring to the Lord as "the God of the spirits of the prophets"(22:6)
6. "And behold, I am coming soon" (22:7) What should we make of this promise, especially considering that it was made more than 1900 years ago?
7. What does it mean, practically speaking to "keep the words of the prophecy of this book"(22:7)
8. How would you summarize the words of Jesus in Revelation 22:10-16? What is he communicating?
9. Should we still take the warning of Revelation 22:18-19 seriously today? If so, What does it mean?
10. Having reached the end of this incredible revelation, If you were going to summarize the overall message in just a few words or phrase's, how would you do it?
