3. In your own words, what has been revealed to John in Revelation 10:1-11?
4. John is not the first person in the Bible told to eat a scroll. Ezekiel was (Ezek 3:1-11). Having taken the time to read both accounts, what similarities do you notice?
5. John was forewarned, "Take and eat it; it will make your stomach full, and your belly will be sweet as honey" (10:9). What was God really telling John about the contents of this scroll?
