2. In your own words, what does Paul want to avoid when he comes to Corinth again (10:2)?
3. What does Paul mean by his reference to “waging war according to the flesh” versus the warfare of faithful children of God (10:3)?
4. What sort of “strongholds” must be destroyed by the soldiers of Christ (10:4)?
5. Why is it vital for Christ’s kingdom citizens to “take every thought captive to obey Christ” (10:5)?
6. In what way is a readiness “to punish every disobedience” an indispensable aspect of bringing obedience to completion (10:6)?
7. What glimpse do we get of the Lord’s motives in providing the apostles with authority in 10:8? Why did God provide such authority to these men?
8. In your own words, summarize Paul’s personal answer to some of the common objections raised against him in 10:9-12.
9. Why does Paul provide the reminder of 10:14 to the Christians in Corinth?
10. Why are Paul’s summarizing thoughts in 10:17-18 still vital for modern disciples of Christ to remember and apply?
