

# Remote Search Widget Setup

A tool has been built into Atrium that will allow you to automatically generate a widget style search box. This box is identical to how it appears on the OPAC. Patrons can use this box on your existing school or library website to generate a search, which will open in the OPAC.

1. Go to Administration > OPAC > Messages and Information > Remote Search Widget Setup.
2. Make sure the settings or options are correct for:

**OPAC Server:** This should point to the external link (eg. <http://atrium.mylibrary.org:80>)

**Header Text:** What you want the box to say

**Search Width:** Length of the box (default 400)

**Background Color:** Select color for the header bar and buttons

**Text Color:** Select the text color

**Buttons:** Select which buttons you want displayed (Keyword, Title, Author, Subject, Series)



**NOTE:** After making a change, you may need to click out of that field for the change to reflect on the preview and code shown at the bottom of the page.

3. Once the preview is correct, copy the code from the box and paste into your website code.

Cut and paste this into your browser page:
